

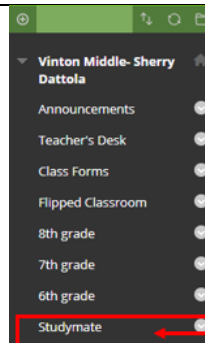
Blackboard "How To's"

Embedding StudyMate

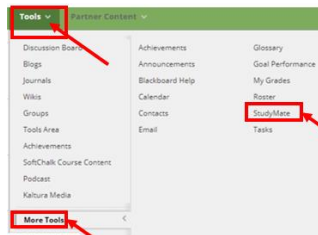
Studymate allows teachers or students to create flash cards, self-assessments, and learning games. It is now fully integrated into Blackboard.

To embed StudyMate:

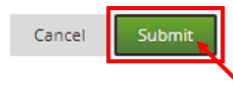
Go to a **content area** in your Blackboard site or add a new content area called Studymate.



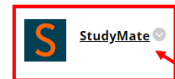
Hover over **Tools**, then click **More Tools** and select **Studymate**.



Click **Submit**.



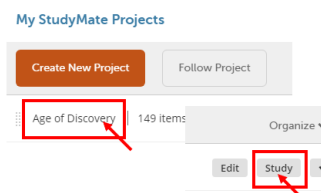
Click on the **StudyMate** icon.



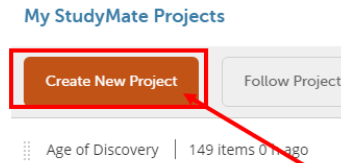
View the **Tutorial** or click **Continue to Studymate**.



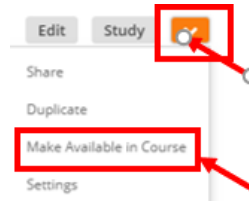
A sample project has been created for you to explore. It is called **Age of Discovery**. Click on **Study** to see the possibilities of the program.



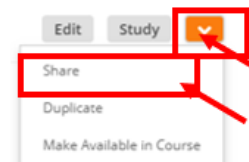
To create your own project, click on **Create New Project**.



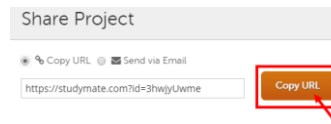
If your students are enrolled in your BB course, then press the drop-down menu and select **Make Available**. You will be able to track student performance.



If your students are not enrolled in your BB site, then you click on **Share**. *Note: Student progress will not be tracked since students are not enrolled in the site.*

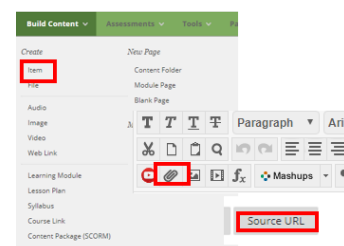


Press **Copy URL**.



Add the URL so that you students can access it by following these steps:

1. In the left Navigation Menu, click on the section where you would like to add the Studymate. This must be a content area.
2. Click on **Build Content**.
3. Click on **Weblink**.
4. Give the link a name such as **Studymate on...**
5. Paste the URL in the URL box.
6. Type any directions that you would like for your students.
7. Click on **Submit**.
